- Quickly see the top conditions and their impact on the member population

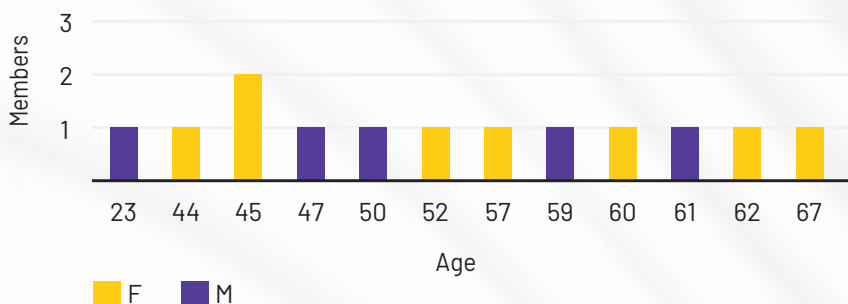

Cost by Disease State - Diabetes

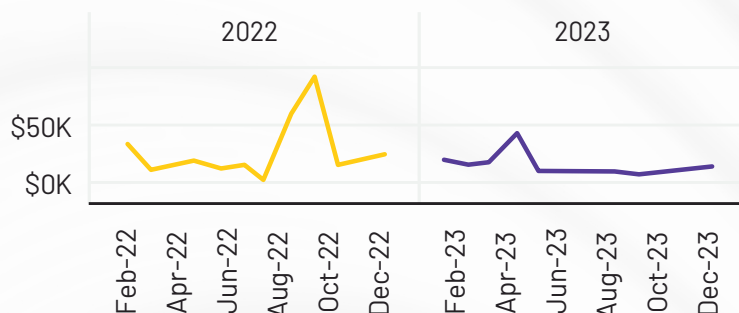
- This allows a more in-depth analysis of a specific condition's impact on various metrics such as ER, inpatient hospitalizations, and medical vs. Rx spend

Claims Trend

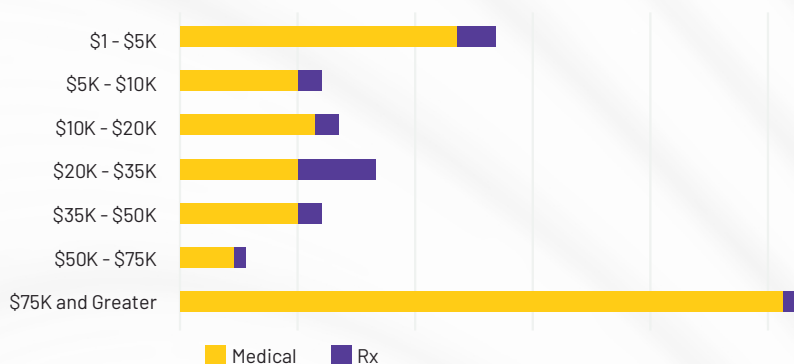
View a rolling 12-months claims history of medical and pharmacy claims

Displays the average spend over time

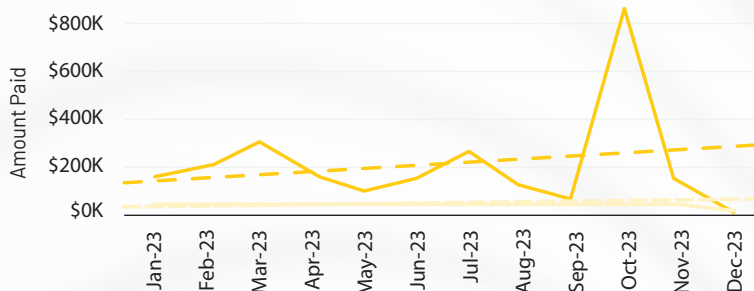
Visualize the monthly breakdown of medical and pharmacy claims by member paid, plan paid, and total plan paid amounts

Specialty Rx Utilization

- Compare a rolling 12-month spend of specialty drugs vs. generic and brand (non-specialty)
- Drill into top specialty drugs by plan paid amount, view member paid amounts, and number of claimants and percent of total pharmacy cost

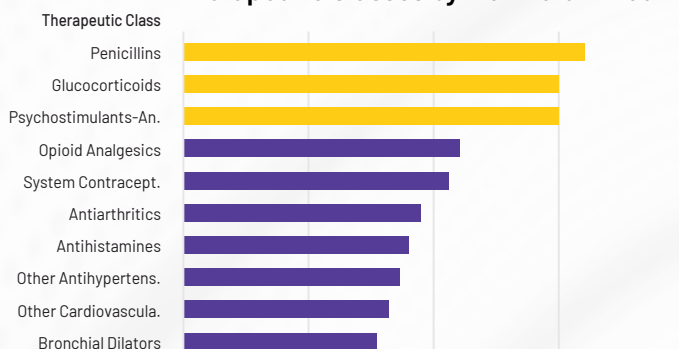
Key Takeaway: Quickly uncover the impact of specialty drugs on the pharmacy plan.

Generic Savings Opportunities

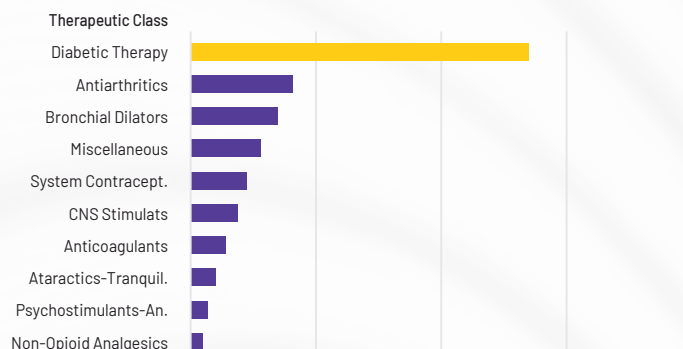
- Analysis of brand and generic usage on the pharmacy benefit plan by comparing plan paid amounts, number of claimants, and average script cost
